DAY 2 SPLIT

Guided tour of **Split UNESCO World Heritage Site**

Split is the largest Dalmatian city and port. 1700 years ago, during the time of Ancient Rome, we will stroll the narrow streets of Diocletian's Palace-UNESCO, built by the 4th century Roman Emperor, tour its excellently preserved basement galleries and visit the old Temple of Jupiter in the central, ancient Peristyle Square, today the city Cathedral and the oldest building of its kind in the world.

We will also pass the protected Golden and Silver Gates, walk through the historical squares to the lively markets and Riva, the ideal place for strolling and shopping.

Local food and market tour.

DAY 3 SPLIT → ZADAR

Scenic coastal drive to Zadar. Guided walking tour of the historic center. Zadar is a city monument, surrounded by historical ramparts, a treasury of the archaeological and monumental riches of ancient and medieval times, Renaissance and many contemporary architectural Achievements such as the first Sea Organ in the world

DAY 4 ZADAR → PLITVICE LAKES → MOSTAR

Morning departure to Plitvice Lakes National Park (UNESCO).

Guided walk among lakes, waterfalls, and wooden pathways

The park features an impressive collection of waterfalls, a series of lakes, lush forests, and a variety of wildlife. The lakes are famous for their vibrant colors, which range from azure and green to gray and blue. Enjoy the astonishing 16 cascading lakes, Waterfalls, Wooden walkways, and protected natural landscapes.

DAY 6 MOSTAR

DAY 7 MOSTAR → PERAST → KOTOR

Scenic mountain and bay drive to Montenegro.

Meet the guide at the border to Montenegro and drive along the bay. Stop in Perast for a short sightseeing tour and embark on a boat to visit Our Lady of the Rocks Island. Continue to Kotor. We will visit:

- Clock Tower
- Flour Square with Pima and Buca palaces
- The Bokelian Navy Square with Karampana
- Northern Gate with Skurda River

DAY 8 KOTOR → DUBROVNIK

Morning free time in Kotor.

Drive along the Adriatic coast to Dubrovnik.

- City walls (exterior)

Upon arrival, enjoy a captivating, guided tour of Dubrovnik, where stunning Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque architecture flourish. Though impacted by conflict in the 1990s, the city is now undergoing a beautiful restoration, expertly coordinated by UNESCO. Discover the charm and resilience of this historic gem.
