DAY	ITINERARY
Day 1 (Feb 16). - Cairo, the Pyramids, and the Sphinx (Optional Tour – Cairo at night/ Light Show)	Arrival at Cairo airport. Greeting service and transfer to the hotel. After resting departure to Giza to visit the funerary complex formed by the pyramids of Keops, Khafre and Mikerinos, pharaohs of the IV dynasty, and the sphinx of Khafre. Accomodation.
Day 2 (Feb 17). - Cairo-Luxor	Breakfast. Transfer to the airport first thing in the morning to take a regular flight to LUXOR. Arrival and transfer to the ship, boarding procedures, and accommodation. visit of the temples of Luxor (dedicated to the God Amon-Ra, God of the Sun) and Karnak, an impressive set of temples and sacred lakes. accommodation on board. Full board.
Day 3 (Feb 18). - Luxor (Karnak) (Optional Tour - Hot Air balloon ride)	Breakfast. Full board. In the morning, visit the Valley of the Kings (tombs of the main Pharaohs) as the explanation of the tombs that are visited inside them is not allowed, our guide will give the explanations outside, (the Tomb of Tutankhamun is not included since all the treasures are in the Egyptian Museum in Cairo). You will also visit the Colossi of Memnon, two impressive statues of Amenophis II as well as the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut on the way to the Valley of the Queens. Full board on the boat. Accommodation on board the ship
Day 4 (Feb 19). - Edfu – Kom-Ombo – Aswan	Full board. Visit to the Temple of Horus (God represented by a falcon), one of the most beautiful temples of the Ptolemaic era in an exceptional state of conservation. Sail to Kom Ombo and visit the temple, the only temple dedicated to two gods, Sobek and Haroesis. We will see a Nilometer (ancient Nile River level measurement system) and a mummified crocodile. Navigation to Aswan. At night you will enjoy the night of the djellabas that you can buy at a reasonable price in the local markets. Accomodation.
Day 5 (Feb 20). - Aswan (Optional Tours – Abu Simbel and Nubian Village)	Free Day. For passengers who wish to do so, they will have the possibility of taking an optional excursion to the Temple of Abu Simbel, which was rescued from the waters, raising it from its original location to save it when Lake Nasser was created, this trip takes place early in the morning (it is convenient to

	indicate this to his arrival in Egypt). You can also visit the Nubian Village, the place of origin of Queen Nefertiti or visit the Nubian Museum in Aswan as well as visit the city. Accommodation. Full board.
Day 6 (Feb 21). - Aswan-Cairo	Breakfast. Visit to the city of Aswan with the Temple of Isis (Philae) which is located on an island accessed by boat, and the quarry with the Unfinished Obelisk and the Aswan dam, one of the largest dams in the world, creating Lake Nasser with a length of more than 500 km. In the afternoon ride in "felucca", typical sailing boats of the area. Disembark and transfer to the airport. Departure on a regular flight to Cairo. Arrival and transfer to the hotel.
Day 7 (Feb 22). - Cairo (Optional Tour – Cairo at night/ Light Show)	Breakfast and departure to visit the Cairo Museum, the Saladin Citadel, the Alabaster Mosque and the Coptic neighborhood, lunch, and free time in the Khan Elk Halili market. Return to the hotel and accommodation
Day 8 (Feb 23). - Cairo-Airport	Breakfast. Transfer to the airport to take your return flight. End of services.
