# Day 1 - April 12, 2025

# **Private | Airport to hotel transfer - Overnight | Bilingual assistance included.** Upon arrival, you will be assisted at the airport and transferred to the hotel.

# Day 2 - April 13, 2025

# Half- Day Lima City Tour. Duration: 3.5 hrs

Today we will discover the two facets of Lima: the modern one, reflected in the districts of Miraflores and San Isidro; and the old one, encapsulated in its historic center, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. During the tour of different districts of the city, we will see how the old and the modern coexist in buildings such as the Museum of Italian Art, the Palace of Justice, the Museum of Lima, Plaza San Martín, among others. We will discover the center of Lima on foot, with the Plaza de Armas as the nerve center: a beautiful colonial square worthy of photographing, surrounded by emblematic buildings such as the Government Palace, the Cathedral and the Archbishop's Palace. We will have the opportunity to enter one of the most iconic ecclesiastical spaces in Lima, such as the Convent of Santo Domingo, also declared a World Heritage Site and where the relics of three Peruvian saints are found: Santa Rosa de Lima, San Martín de Porres and San Juan Macías. Leaving the historic center, we will return to modern Lima, the one that meets the Pacific Ocean offering a fascinating view that we can enjoy from the iconic Parque del Amor and its famous sculpture created by national artist Víctor Delfín.

# City half day, San Pedro MKT and nearby ruins. Duration: 4 hrs

This charming half-day tour of Cusco offers us history, living culture and art. We will be able to appreciate how Andean and Spanish culture, as well as the past and the present, coexist in harmony in the Imperial City. We will arrive at the center to walk through the corridors of the San Pedro market, the oldest in the city. Designed in 1925 by Gustave Eiffel, today it brings together hundreds of merchants selling local products. We will also visit the Koricancha , which during the Inca Empire was a center of worship to the Sun and on which the Santo Domingo convent was later built as part of the evangelization process. Its baroque-style façade built on solid Inca walls perfectly sums up the syncretism of cultures in the city of Cusco. To appreciate the grandeur of the Incas, we will ascend to the monumental fortress of Sacsayhuamán, which with its enormous carved stone walls constitutes one of the best examples of Inca military architecture. We will also visit the archaeological center of Kenko , a ceremonial place where the Sun, the Moon and the stars were worshipped. We could not take a tour of the city without visiting the Cathedral, the most important temple in the entire city. It was built by the Spanish on the palace of the Inca Huiracoha . Its interior houses a wonderful collection of colonial art made up of pieces of goldsmithing and representative paintings of the Cusco School.

# Full day Machu Picchu Standard with lunch.

One of the most important tourist attractions in the world awaits us: Machu Picchu!

Our adventure will begin aboard a train bound for Aguas Calientes, also known as Machu Picchu Pueblo, a picturesque town at the foot of the iconic Inca citadel. During the train ride we will be able to enjoy the natural beauty of the surroundings, with breathtaking views of majestic mountains, rivers and small towns of the Peruvian Andes; a visual feast that fills us with anticipation for the visit to the wonder that is Machu Picchu. After a short bus ride from Aguas Calientes we will find ourselves in front of one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World – it will be an unforgettable sight! From there, we will explore the incredible ruins, learning all about the history and mysteries that this mystical and impressive place holds. With incomparable landscapes everywhere, there will be no shortage of opportunities to take spectacular photos! Once we have recharged ourselves with the magical energy of Machu Picchu we will return to Aguas Calientes where we will have free time to have lunch and walk around the streets a bit before boarding our return train.

# Day 5 - April 16, 2025

# Full day in the Authentic Sacred Valley and Moray. Duration: 8.5 hrs

In the Sacred Valley we will find ancient history and living culture. We will visit Chinchero, where we will learn about its traditional textiles and the symbolism that their designs and colors contain by visiting the Parwa cultural center . We will have the opportunity to appreciate the textile process of each piece, the supplies used, the method of obtaining its natural dyes and the weaving techniques that are passed down from generation to generation. In addition, we will be able to see the work of the artisans in person. We will also arrive at the archaeological complex of Chinchero, one of the most impressive in the area that during the Tahuantinsuyu was an agricultural and livestock center, with terraces and aqueducts. Nearby, we will see the exterior of the Nuestra Señora de Monserrat church built in 1607 on the old Inca palace and which today is an example of the confluence of Andean and Spanish culture during the Viceroyalty, especially in the artistic aspect of its decoration. We will continue to delve deeper into the Inca world in Moray, which during the Tahuantinsuyu served as a laboratory and agricultural research center according to some studies. Its enormous concentric terraces and the variety of microclimates they created allowed the growth of a wide variety of crops. We will enjoy the local flavor in a restaurant during lunch and continue to Ollantaytambo, an ancient military, religious and agricultural center of the Incas. We will tour the main temple and the terraces of the stone fortress. Its fortress, a display of all the Inca power, is strategically located on a mountain, where we will tour its main temple, terraces and fountains, while enjoying an unbeatable view of the town, the only one that maintains the original Inca urban design and where we will be able to see its stone streets, its market and breathe the spirit of the Andes.





# Day 6 - April 17, 2025

### Full day rainbow mountain. Duration: 12 hrs

Vinicunca, or the Mountain of Seven Colors, is one of the most popular attractions in Cusco. We will leave the hotel early to head to Cusipata and from there we will travel to Phulawasipata, the starting point of the hike up. The path will be the perfect excuse to enjoy the nature of the place: herds of llamas and alpacas, as well as the majestic Apu Ausangate, the highest snow-capped mountain in Cusco. We will also be able to talk with the local community members and see the potato fields they work on every day. After approximately an hour and a half of walking, we will arrive at Vinicunca, at 5,020 meters above sea level. The view we will get will be the best reward. The minerals that make up the soil of the mountain give its slopes and summit curious shades of red, purple, green, yellow and pink, among other colors. Let's get our cell phones and cameras ready for this spectacle! From there we will begin the journey back to Phulawasipata . After walking a total of 8 km, we will head towards Cusipata , where we will enjoy a restorative traditional lunch.
